

### Parting Thoughts from Bob Beville

Missed last week's meeting?

If you weren't at last week's meeting, I spoke about "Cutting the Cord," which refers to canceling TV Cable or satellite and how you can save money. I explained the steps you need to take before you call and cancel.

- Are you under a contract with your current provider?
- What are your viewing habits presently? Do you watch local TV stations? Do you have multiple TVs or online gaming consoles?
- Do you have an Antenna, or do you know that for \$25, you can get a great one and over 50 local channels for FREE

Explore what Internet providers have services in your neighborhood. You may get 5G service, a telephone that makes your house a Wi-Fi hotspot that your TVs and devices connect to. This can be as low as \$40 per month or up to \$75 per month. Xfinity Wi-Fi would run about \$75 per month.

A service like YouTube TV or Hulu TV, which gives you all the local stations and most of the national "cable" networks, would cost about \$75 per month. If you have Cable TV now, it would be almost identical.

I also compared the costs of major streaming services, such as Netflix, HBO/MAX, Disney, Hulu, Apple TV, and more. Let me know if you need help navigating through the somewhat complex decision to "Cut the Cord." But I promise you will be glad you did! Finally, I asked the attendees how they currently watch TV. You can see how the attendees compare to the Ft Myers-Naples market and the Total U.S.






