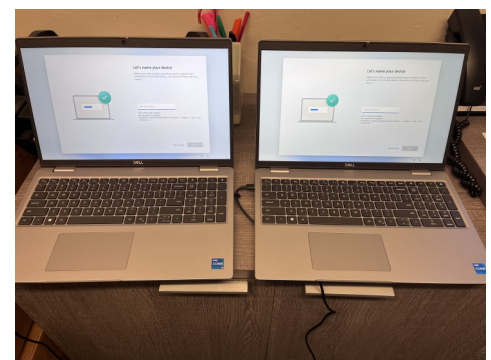
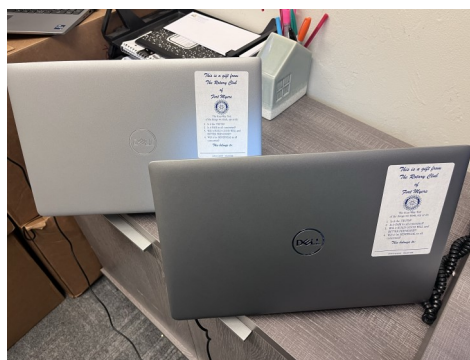
Our speaker this week is Tommy Doyle, the supervisor of elections. This is always a great program. Come early to get a good seat. Tommy never disappoints.

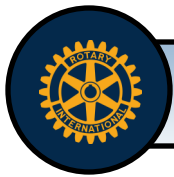
